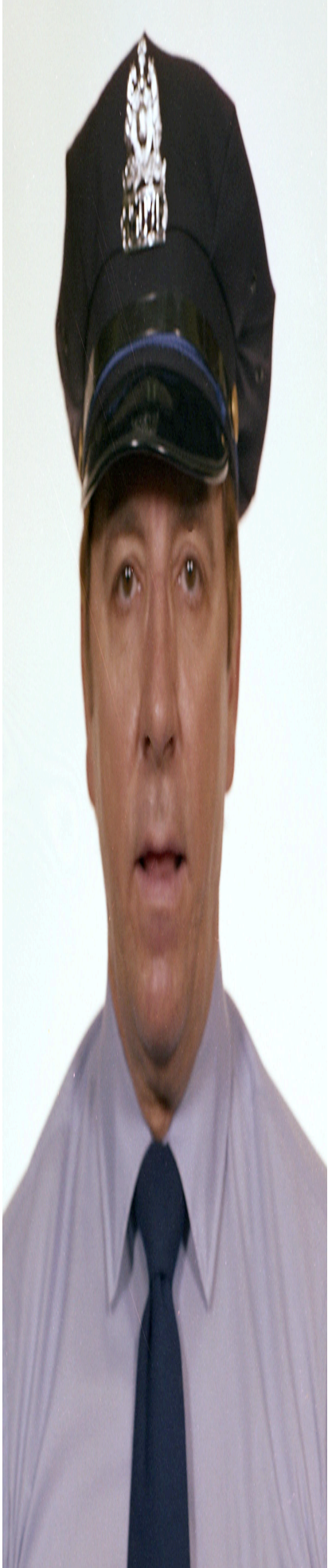


William E. Laub - Obituary

Age 82, died Sept. 21.
